LOCAL RULES

- U.S.G.A. Rules of Golf will govern all play, except where modified by local rules
- Alternative to Stroke and Distance for Lost Ball or Ball out of Bounds: Please see Model Local Rule E-5 in the USGA Official Guide to the Rules of Golf But, the player may not use this option when: The ball is known or virtually certain to have come to rest in a penalty area, or The player has played another ball provisionally under penalty of stroke and distance (see Rule 18.3)."
- Penalty Areas All penalty areas, except a portion of #9 Salvation, are marked by red lines, red stakes or defined by rock walls. Where #9 Salvation is marked with yellow lines/ stakes players will take relief under 17.1d as a yellow penalty area. All rock walls inside the boundary of the penalty areas are deemed to be an integral part of the golf course, therefore are not obstructions. Where the rock wall is used to define the margin of the penalty area, the margin is the fairway/bunker side of the rock wall. A player is not entitled to relief, without penalty. Penalty Area Drop Zones - Drop Zones are located on Redemption #8, Salvation #4, Trepidation #3, and Trepidation #7.
- Out Of Bounds Defined by white stakes. All roadways are considered out of bounds. When stakes are not present, the closest curb to the course will define the out of bounds. Abnormal Course Conditions - Marked by white lines. If in doubt, you may invoke rule 20.1(3) and play a second ball (stroke play only) and receive a ruling at the completion of the round.
- Course Preservation No Play Zone Annuals behind #9 Redemption will be treated as a no play zone with relief as nearest point.
- Immovable Obstructions Relief from interference by an immovable obstruction may be taken under Rule 16.1. All cart paths and their aprons, sprinkler heads, sprinkler control boxes and comfort stations. The landscaped areas located on #7 Trepidation and #4 Salvation are going to be treated as a continuation of the cart path. Free relief is nearest point of relief & one club length, no closer to the hole. In addition, if a ball lies through the green and an immovable obstruction (e.g., Sprinkler Head or Valve Cover Box) on or within two club-lengths of the putting green and within two club-lengths of the ball intervenes on the line of play between the ball and the hole, the player may take relief as follows: the ball must be lifted and dropped at the nearest point to where the ball lay that (a) is not nearer the hole, (b) avoids intervention and (c) is not in a hazard or on a putting green. The ball may be cleaned when lifted.

Course Information

- All distances measured to center of green.
- Please repair ball marks, replace divots with sand & rake all bunkers.
- Standard pace of play is 4 hrs & 8 min.
- Men playing the Mixed Tee must tee off from the tee box marked with both the Black and Green tee markers placed side-by-side on holes #3 Salvation and #9 Trepidation.
